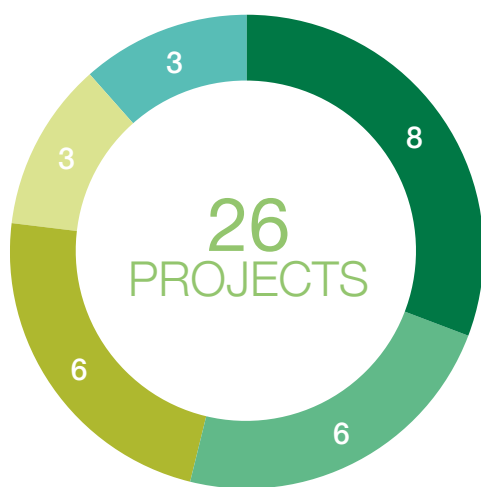

### *Our Support Enables:*

Project “Befriending service for Lightning up and Empowering Survivors of Suicide” or “BLESS” is to be a bridge between bereaved families and support systems in the community, that empower survivors to regain the will to carry on. This includes raising public awareness of the needs of suicide survivors and active postvention programs through therapeutic programs, producing informative videos, mutual support groups and individual, family or group counselling.

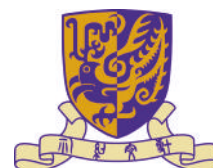
